

### The main building



The main building - named "Building A"

The main building has got a historic/ modern/	
ancient/ residential architecture.	
It has got a gable/shed/flat/hipped/mansard roof top.	
One side of the building consists of octagonal/	
rectangular/elliptical/round large plastic frame	
windows.	
The wall at the window side is cladded with brick-,	
wood-, concrete-, marble- plates.	
At the front side of the building you can see a large	
chimney/ artwork/ logo/ balcony.	
The building has got five <i>storeys</i> , <i>stages</i> , <i>floors</i> , <i>layers</i> .	
A balcony/ canopy/ roof/ gutter protects the main	
entrance against rainfall.	
This building is a typical industrial/ residential/	
historical building




This building is in the near of air/ sports/
