

- ightarrow 500 WLAN hotspots to be installed by the end of 2018



Prices for closely connected commercial property and real estate in the cities and municipalities of Upper Franconia are the lowest in Bavaria. Thanks to the region's excellent transportation links, major cities like Munich, Berlin, Prague, Nuremberg and Frankfurt are only a stone's throw away. From the trading hub Upper Franconia, a total of around 60 million consumers can be reached by car in three hours or less.

Driving progress in Upper Franconia

Upper Franconia is a powerhouse of innovation! Companies in the region file more than a thousand new patent applications a year. As specialist suppliers, they're indispensable partners to the aerospace, automotive and healthcare sectors.

From the Airbus A 380 to wind turbines, from packaging machines to oxygen supplies for hospital operating rooms – products from the region's companies are now marketed worldwide. What's more: There's a bit of Upper Franconia in virtually every car on the road today.

- → Upper Franconia is home to over 80 world market leaders four times the German average
- → Upper Franconian innovators apply for more than 1,000 patents a year twice the German average
- → In Upper Franconia there are universities in four cities: Bamberg, Bayreuth, Coburg and Hof, with additional branches in Kronach, Kulmbach and Münchberg
- → Upper Franconia boasts a large number of centers of excellence and research institutes in the areas of high-temperature lightweight construction, polymer technology, fiber and composite technology, textiles, sensors, and energy and water technology

Hot spots for research and development

Universities in the cities of Bamberg, Bayreuth, Hof and Coburg – together with their branches in Kronach, Kulmach and Münchberg and their many research institutes – are key partners for innovation and company development.

Intensively focused on cooperation with local businesses, Upper Franconia's research infrastructure and regional areas of expertise – including the Center of Competence for New Materials, the Bavarian Polymer Institute, the Fraunhofer Project Group Process Innovation, the Fraunhofer Center for High-Temperature

Materials and Design, the Fraunhofer Department for Integrated Sensor Systems and the Center of Competence for Energy and Water as well as the specialist university departments for future design in Kronach, for nutrition and health in Kulmbach and for textile design in Münchberg – are steadily expanding.
